INVITATION TO ONLINE TRAINING ON THE WEB-BASED STATISTICAL APPLICATION FOR COLLEGES OF EDUCATION

The National Commission for Colleges of Education (NCCE) has developed a web-based statistical application to improve data submission and reporting across Colleges of Education. To ensure effective deployment, each College was requested to nominate two (2) officers for training, and a collaborative platform was created to support Desk Officers and NCCE staff.

2. Although four (4) training sessions with practical demonstrations have been conducted, participation and data submissions from Colleges have remained below expectation. To address this challenge, the Commission is organizing another training session for Desk Officers.
